Comments: Malheur ESD plans to receive funding from Wildhorse Casino (\$20,000), Ford Foundation (\$30,000), Umpqua Bank (\$100,000) which were unknown at budget time. State Funds for Kindergarten Partnership and Innovation will be increased in 2015-16 to cover additional personnel cost in the amount of \$4,000.00 for wages and \$2,000.00 in benefits.

There was also a beginning fund balance that was not accounted for in the amount of \$10,000.
