

CCR INITIATIVE FACT SHEET

DUAL CREDIT REIMBURSEMENT

WHAT IS IT?

- ⇒ The College Credit Reimbursement (CCR) Initiative refers to a \$33,560 grant awarded by the Oregon Department of Education to the Malheur Education Service District in 2018.
- ⇒ 100% of this \$33,560 will go directly towards reimbursing students in Malheur County and Huntington for **dual/college credit tuition**
- ⇒ Eligible courses for reimbursement are **not restricted to TVCC** dual credit. However, students need to seek the most reasonably priced course before submitting for reimbursement.
- ⇒ All \$33,560 must be spent by June 30, 2019.

WHAT ARE THE RULES?

- ⇒ Student must **pass course for college credit during the 2018-19 school year**.
- ⇒ Students may receive reimbursement for up to **2 classes per college term**.
- ⇒ A reevaluation of grant funds will be conducted in January 2019 to determine how to equally disperse remaining dollars to college credit students over the subsequent academic terms.

HOW DO I APPLY?

- 1) Complete the CCR Initiative Application Form.
- 2) Attach your unofficial college transcript.
- 3) Attach a copy of your billing statement or tuition payment receipt.
- 4) Submit your application form and attachments to your counselor or high school office.
